




Kyowa Exeo Corporation and JICT Decide to Finance Indoor Communication Infrastructure Sharing Business in Indonesia

Kyowa Exeo Corporation (headquartered in Shibuya-ku, Tokyo; President: Tetsuya Funabashi) and Fund Corporation for the Overseas Development of Japan's ICT and Postal Services (hereinafter, "JICT") (headquartered in: Chiyoda-ku, Tokyo; President & CEO: Yoshiyuki Fukuda) are pleased to announce that they have decided to jointly finance a local subsidiary of Kyowa Exeo Corporation, which is engaged in indoor communication infrastructure sharing business* in Indonesia, to support the expansion of their business. The Minister for Internal Affairs and Communications today approved JICT's finance of up to approximately 2.2 billion yen or the equivalent to the local subsidiary of Kyowa Exeo Corporation.

*A business to build indoor antenna equipment, etc. in facilities with high-telecommunication traffic needs, on behalf of telecommunication carriers, and neutrally provide the equipment to multiple telecommunication carriers together with operation and maintenance services.
